While it is perhaps a little late to wish everyone in the ICN community a Happy New Year for 2025, we should nevertheless take time to celebrate the school's news and plans for this year and beyond. New in Berlin: ICN has had to leave its Q207 campus due to major building work, and has therefore relocated. The Berlin campus, which will be fully completed in May and inaugurated in the Autumn, will occupy 2 floors within a complex featuring a hotel, a variety of restaurants and a promenade on the banks of the River Spree in a green and dynamic district of central Berlin. The two floors include a cafeteria with a patio, a knowledge hub, a Bloomberg room, spaces for both

students and staff and, of course, classrooms. All alumni from Berlin (and beyond!) are welcome to contact us to arrange a visit of the new campus.

This means that we are quadrupling our current surface area in order to welcome a large number of students, particularly international, but also from our new degree programme - the 4-year international bachelor's degree (see below).

Today, **38% of the school's students** are foreign nationals, as are half of its teaching staff.

The school has a network of **128 partner schools** in 46 countries, a network which evolves and is strengthened each year in order to extend the international offering of the school.

Every year, ICN welcomes students from foreign partner universities who come to spend a semester

at ICN or prepare for a degree at the school. Every year, ICN students go on academic placements in one of our partner universities. In addition, ICN has signed **double degree agreements** with renowned institutions such as HEC Liège, Galway in Ireland and Hanyang in South Korea.
